Protect Your pet from fleas

Regular grooming

Brushing your pet's fur regularly can help you identify and remove fleas and flea dirt (feces).



Use flea preventatives

Consult with your veterinarian to determine which product is best for your pet based on their age, weight, and overall health.



Treat your yard

Fleas can also be present in your yard, so it is important to keep your lawn trimmed and free of debris, and treat outdoor areas with flea control products.



Keep your home clean

Fleas can lay eggs in carpets, furniture, and bedding, so it is important to vacuum your home regularly, wash your pet's bedding in hot water, and clean any areas where your pet spends time.



Practice good hygiene

Wash your hands after handling your pet, and keep your pet away from other animals that may have fleas.
